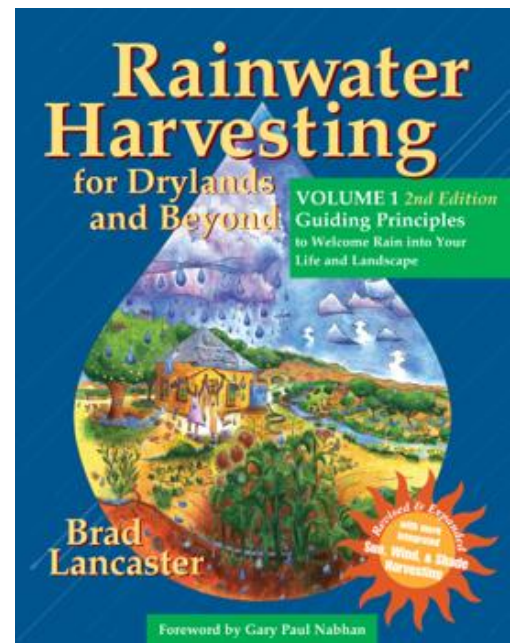
Indoor seating will begin at 6:15 PM
