I agree to ensure proper maintenance of the curb core(s)/cut(s), water-harvesting basin(s), and vegetation planted in the public Right-of-Way (ROW) /s common area in proximity to the above property for as long as I own the property, with the understanding that future owners will also be required to maintain landscaping planted in these areas per locally applicable ordinances.

## Maintenance includes:

- Maintaining healthy perennial vegetation within the water-harvesting basin to utilize and infiltrate the harvested stormwater;
- Pruning & weeding to ensure vegetation does not cause any traffic-visibility hazards;
- Pruning & weeding to maintain a continuous minimum 5'-wide walking path cleared to
- a minimum height of 7' for the entire length of the right-of-way;
- Removing any invasive plants/weeds such as buffel grass (Pennisetum ciliare), fountain grass (Pennisetum setaceum), and Bermuda grass (Cynodon dactylon) from the area;
- · Removing litter; and
- Keeping the curb-core hole or curb cut clear of debris to ensure street runoff flows freely into the adjoining basin

## Important notes:

- \* Plant trees AT LEAST 10 feet from sewer lines, 5 feet from water lines, and 3 feet from other utility lines.
- \* To ensure no conflict/contact with overhead utility lines, do not plant under such lines any vegetation whose mature height will exceed 15 feet.
- \* Do not plant in public Right-of-Way (ROW) without both a permit & Blue Stake clearance (dial 811 or (800) 782-5348).

I agree to hold Trees for Tucson, the Dunbar/Spring Neighborhood Association, and all
volunteer tree planters and organizers harmless for all liability associated with the curb coring,
basins, or vegetation planting and maintenance.
